Visitor attractions and activities

- Natural attractions: physical features such as waterfalls, mountains and valleys that attract visitors
- Historic sites: places such as ancient monuments and old buildings that have become attractions for visitors
- Theme parks: large attractions including rides that are spread over a large site
- Major sports/entertainment venues: nationally important sports or entertainment facilities such as stadia, arenas and theatres
- Built attractions: facilities such as museums, and galleries that have been specifically built to attract visitors

Natural Attraction UK: Giants Causeway

- Located in Northern Ireland on the Atlantic Ocean. It is a 33 mile stretch of coastline.
- It has a wild landscape positioned in front of dramatic cliffs
- Basalt columns
- ☐ For centuries the Giant's Causeway has inspired artists, stirred scientific debate and captured the imagination of all who see it.
- ☐ Hike along the cliff-top trail or climb the shepherd's steps, get an audio guide to go with your walk
- Award winning visitors centre has exhibition about the landscape, café, retail zone and souvenir shop
- ☐ Entry = £10.50 for adults, £5.25 children
- ☐ Local train station is Coleraine then Ulsterbus Service 172

Natural Attraction Abroad: Niagara Falls

Niagara Falls is the collective name for 3 waterfalls that straddle the international border between Canada and the United States of America. More specifically between the province of Ontario and New York state.
 The individual names for the three falls are: Horseshoe Falls, American Falls and Bridal Veil Falls.
 The waterfalls are located on the Niagara river.
 The vertical drop is 50 metres.
 The falls have lights displays until midnight to attract tourists in the evenings as well as day time.
 About 28 million tourists visit Niagara Falls a year.
 You can do a boat cruise called the 'Maid of the Mist'
 There are lots of nice gardens near by the falls on the Canadian side but also a lot of hotels and casinos. It is in a built up town area.

Historic Site UK: Windsor Castle

- Located in South East England in the County of Berkshire
- Home to British Kinds and Queens for over 1000 years.
- 13 acres of land
- It is the largest and oldest occupied castle in the world and is where the Queen spends most her weekends
- You can see where Henry the 8th and Charles the 1st are buried in St Georges Chapel.
- You can see the largest dolls house in the world.

Historic Site Abroad: Colosseum Rome

- Located in the city centre of Rome, Northern Italy, Europe
- Also known as the Flavian Amphitheatre
- Oval shaped amphitheatre built of concrete and stone
- Largest amphitheatre ever built
- Historically the amphitheatre could hold between 50,000 and 80,000 spectators
- It was used for gladiatorial contests, public spectacles, animal hunts, executions, re-enactments of famous battles and dramas
- It is partially ruined because of damage from an earthquake and stone-robbers but is still an iconic symbol of the Roman Empire and one of the most popular tourist attractions in Italy.
- Over 4 million tourists a year visit the Colosseum, making it the worlds 39th most popular tourist destination








Theme Parks UK: Thorpe Park

- "Island like no other" = slogan
- Thorpe Park is located in South East England close to Heathrow Airport
- Over 30 rides
- 5 of the UK's top Roller Coasters
- Stay over at the Jawesome Shark Hotel
- Derren Brown's Ghost Train Rise of the Demon
- Owned by Merlin Entertainments
- Opened in 1979
- It is built on an island so has lots of water based rides

Theme Parks Abroad: 6 Flags

- Located in Arlington, Texas, USA
- The thrill capital of Texas
- Home to more than 100 rides
- 13 world class roller coasters
- 212 acres
- First 6 flags theme park
- Opened 1961
- Managed by Six Flags Entertainment Corporation
- Name refers to the 6 nations that have governed Texas: Spain, France, Mexico, Republic of Texas, USA and Confederate State of America.








Major sports and entertainment venue: UK Wembley Stadium

- Located in North West London, South East, England
- Seats 90,000 people.
- Used for sports and music concerts where the pitch is covered by specially designed protective panels to create extra space for 25,000 people
- It's iconic sliding roof covers every seat in the stadium, making it the largest fully covered stadium in the world
- The stadium as we know it today opened in 2007



Major sports and entertainment venue: UK Wembley Stadium















Major sports and entertainment venue abroad: Fenway Park

Major sports and entertainment venue abroad: Fenway Park










Built Attractions: UK British Museum




- Located in Bloomsbury London






Built Attractions: Museum of Modern Art New York

- Located in Midtown Manhattan in New York City on 53rd Street between 5th and 6th Avenue
- Shortened to MoMA
- MoMA is one of the largest and most influential museums of modern art in the world
- Works of drawing, painting, sculpture, photography, prints, illustrated books, film and electronic media
- MoMA library includes 300,000 books
- Opened on 7th November 1928
- 3.1 million visitors a year visit MoMA
