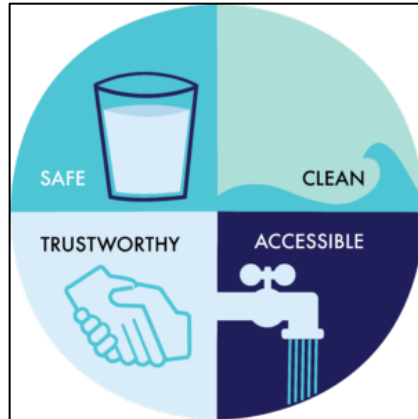

Agricultural training to improve food security



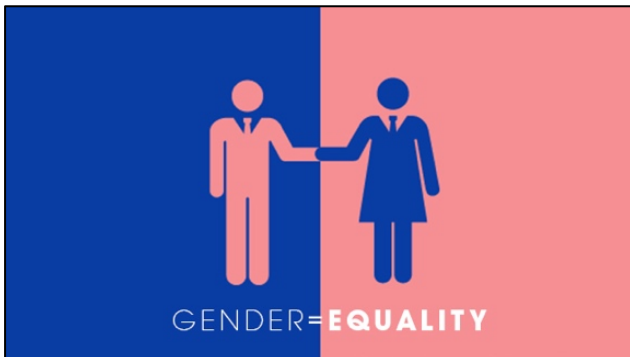
Building of democratic institutions

Border control to facilitate movement of people and goods

Rule of law strengthened



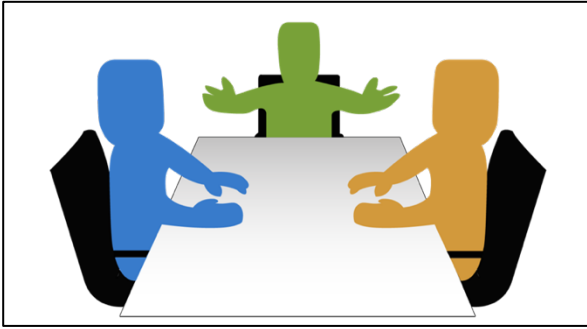

Development of sustainable food and water supplies



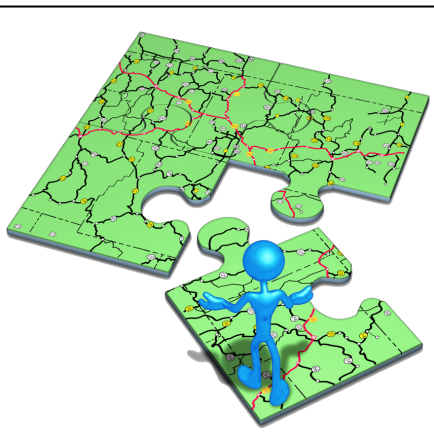
Improving trade relationships to help reduce effects of economic shock
